

DX NEWS

E6AQ Niue -update November 4

'Less than a week to go. The conditions on the bands except for 10 meters are changing for the worse. It's a bit better at 40m, but contacts with Europe on this band are extremely difficult (not to mention 80m). The 10m band is still great, although the opening to Europe (approx 0700Z) is short. I am very close to the ocean, but I can see it in the west. The signal in the north direction, where there are many potential correspondents, has to pass through half a kilometer of tropical forest.'

VK9CV Cocos Keeling Isl -update November 6

'The RX antenna on 160m is picking up some industrial noise from the island at S6-7. Weaker signals are not coming through. Conditions on all bands are very variable; two days ago, it was great, yesterday very weak. There are 13 CW contacts in the log on 60m. This is an error caused by a communication issue between the radio and PC. Those contacts belong to 20m CW. 60m is not permitted in VK. However, we'll make the log corrections once we're back home.'

3D2Y Rotuma DXpedition -update

We plan to make every effort to hand out as many 6 meter QSOs as possible. Our 6 meter station consists of an Elecraft K4 + KPA 500. Our 6 meter antenna is a Momo 5 element @ 20 ft that will be positioned to take advantage of the moon's location at the horizon for moon rise and moon set. 6m EME operations will be captained by Don N1DG, and all of our EME operators will be remote. Our 6 meter EME schedule will be published in advance. Working EME with a small team DXpedition is a challenge, by utilizing our remote team we can leverage their expertise resulting in a much better opportunity to make as many EME contacts as possible.

6 meter terrestrial operations will be manned by a mix of local and remote operators. We will monitor PSK reporter the ON4KST chat room for openings. We are able to receive notifications of potential openings in real-time.

3D2/R, ROTUMA Antoine, 3D2AG mentions 'However, things are getting more stable now and I will be trying to be active as much as possible on 20-10m, and also 6m now that the 5-el yagi has been put up. Being on my own, it will remain to be seen if I manage to setup any 80m and 160m before I have to leave the second week of November. I am also involved in work related to Surface Seawater Temperature (SST) monitoring of the coastal waters off Rotuma, and some SCUBA diving will need to take place.

Concerning operating, I am focusing mainly on SSB and CW, with some digimodes when there are no takers elsewhere (single stream on normal operating frequencies, or multistream on DX frequencies (28090, for instance). Usually all digimodes are using solar power and about 30W output into the Spiderbeam. For SSB and CW, I have one ACOM 600S linear.'

3D2, **FIJI** Theo, PA3CBH will be active as 3D2TP from Suva during November 8 and December 12. QRV during his spare time QRP using CW and SSB. QSL via home call.

5X, UGANDA Don, G3XTT (as 5X1DF) informs DX-World that he will be returning to Uganda in November with Alan G3XAQ (as 5X1XA). They will be there from 13 to 27 November but primarily to take part in the CQWW CW contest. Both will enter as a single-band category – in Don's case 40m and in Alan's probably 15 or 10m. Also likely to QRV prior to the contest on various bands; CW and probably some FT8. QSL 5X1XA via G3SWH and 51XDF via G3XTT.

8Q, MALDIVES Tom, OE1TRI is active from Kagi Island as 8Q7TR until November 9. Operation in 'holiday-style' with low power using SSB and FT8. QSL via home call. https://www.qrz.com/db/8Q7TR

8R, GUYANA Aldir, PY1SAD is active as 8R1TM from Georgetown until November 24. Operation on all bands using CW, SSB and digi. QSL via LoTW and direct.

E5, COOK ISL Active earlier this year from Wallis & Futuna and New Caledonia, Stan LZ1GC and Ted LZ5QZ are again on Pacific travels. First stop will be Rarotonga, Cook Islands

as E51SGC (second stop A35GC, Tonga). Dates for E51SGC: November 6-24 from 160 to 6 meter using CW, SSB, FT8/FT4 & RTTY. QSL via LZ1GC, LoTW, Club Log OQRS.

E6, NIUE Jacek, SP5EAQ is operating as E6AQ until November 9. The QTH is on the western side of the island, right by the ocean. This will be a SSB only operation from 80 to 10 meter. An entry in the CQWW SSB contest is included. QSL via SP7DQR.

FO, FRENCH POLYNESIA Laurent, N5LCP will be active from Bora Bora as FO/call between November 11 and November 16. Activity on 20 and 15 meter using SSB and FT8. QSL via home call and LoTW.

FR, REUNION ISL Jean, F5SGI is active as FR/call until November 18. Operation on HF using CW. QSL via home call bureau or LoTW.

FW, WALLIS & FUTUNA Since November 1st, Barry KD6XU has been QRV from Uvea, Wallis Island. Initially we weren't sure if he was active /MM from his sailboat just offshore Wallis & Futuna but he confirms via social media (Facebook) that he's been on land at all times when transmitting. Look for him on CW, QRP. APRS locator here.

FY, FRENCH GUIANA Sebastien, F8DQZ (ex-3XY3D) is active from French Guiana as FY/F8DQZ until November 8. He is there on a business trip but will QRV when time permits on HF bands (Yagi and IC-7300). QSL via F5OZC.

JD1, OGASAWARA Makoto, JI5RPT are once again active as JD1BLY until November 10. Operation from 40 to 6 meter and Sats. Focus on HF using FT8 and on GreenCube. QSL via Club Log and LoTW.

PZ, SURINAME Look for PZ5JT this October and November during a jungle training of the Royal Dutch Army. The station is manned by personnel from the signal regiment on 40, 20, 17, 15 and 10 meter using SSB. PZ5JT will be using in-service military radio's (L3Harris) from different locations, but most of the time from main (command) post – keep your ears open for a special /M or /P from more challenging locations.

S9, SAO TOME A team consisting N4XP, 5B4AQN, CT1BOL, CT1EEB, HI8RD, I8NHJ, KH7U, KJ7KOJ, KOIR, K3VN, N2WB, N6MZ, WB4JTT and W7YED will be active from Sao Tome as S9Z during November 11-20. QRV with 6 stations - four for general operations (CW, SSB and digital), one for 6 metres and RTTY and one for EME, a position for QO-100 Satellite will also be made available. Plans are for S9Z to operate CW, SSB, FT8 (Super Fox) and RTTY on 160-6 metres (see the band plan on the DXpedition's website), and to use Club Log's Livestream. QSL via OQRS (direct and bureau), or direct to N4NHW.

TR, GABON Roland, F8EN is once again QRV as TR8CR until mid-January 2025. Operation from

30-10 meter using CW. QSL via F6AJA.

V3, BELIZE Tom, AK2G is QRV as V31TL until November 14. He will be QRV mainly from POTA sites BZ-0057 (Altun Ha Archeological Reserve) and BZ-0067 (Community Baboon Sanctuary); then (10-14 November) he "will be on the ocean and heading to BZ-0075 (Half Moon Caye Marine Reserve) and possibly BZ-0072 (Turneffe Atoll Marine Reserve). QSL direct to home call.

V4, ST KITTS Look for W5JON as V47JA from Calypso Bay until November 15. Activity from 160 to 6 meter using SSB and FT8 with a Yaesu FT-3000D, and Elecraft KPA500 amplifier. Antennas: Mosley MP-32N beam for 10/15/20m, 33' vertical for 10-80m and a 6m Yagi. QSL direct to W5JON or via LoTW.

V5, NAMIBIA The Norwegian ARD is QRV as V55LA until November 11. During this period, the V55LA team will be active on all HF bands (CW, SSB, Digi), with a particular focus on the low bands. Our team consists of experienced operators skilled in "human modes", so you can expect to hear plenty of activity on both CW and SSB throughout the expedition where it is needed for most of you. 


